The University of Toronto Pension Plan also has a portability provision which permits the transfer of pension funds from a Registered Pension Plan of a previous Canadian employer to provide additional pension service in the University of Toronto Pension Plan, and is based on the amount of funds actually transferred. This application must be submitted to the University by the Member within twelve (12) months following the date upon which the Member joined the University of Toronto Pension Plan. The transferred service will be administered based on the Ontario "Pension Benefits Act".
